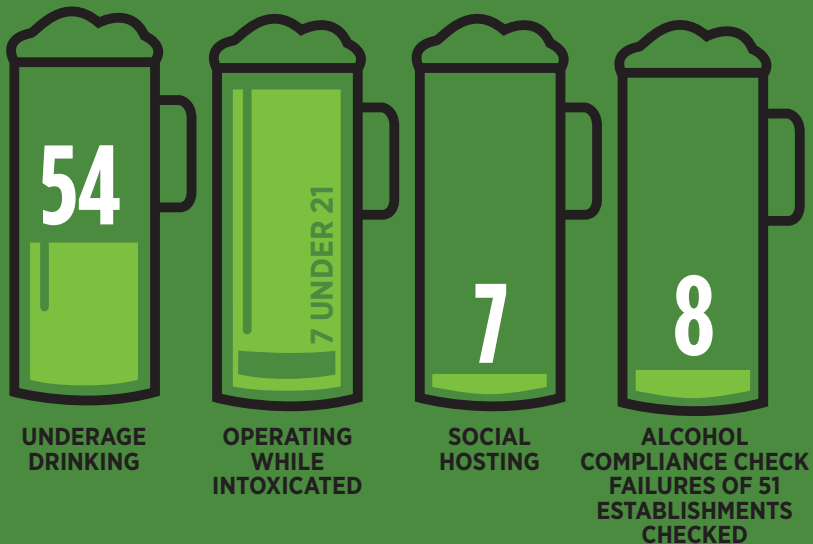
32% OF MARSHFIELD AREA HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS HAD AT LEAST 1 DRINK OF ALCOHOL

Of those reporting use, 51.4% obtained alcohol from someone else within the past 30 days and 33.6% obtained alcohol from a convenience store, grocery store, bar or paid someone to purchase it for them.
