Marshfield Area Parent Network (MAPN) is a group of parents, guardians, educators and community members committed to looking out for the well-being of youth. MAPN strives to provide a safe and healthy environment free from bullying, alcohol and other drug use, and promotes safe internet and texting use, healthy relationships and other issues relevant to youth.

The parent network was started in 2002 in Marshfield, with the help of former Marshfield High School principal John Blankush. His vision was to create a network of parents and guardians who would sign a pledge to provide and support places for youth to socialize away from pressure to use tobacco, alcohol and other illegal substances.

In 2007, MAPN became part of Marshfield Area Coalition for Youth, supported by Marshfield Clinic Center for Community Outreach. Since its inception, MAPN includes more than 900 parents and guardians of youth in grades 4K through 12, as well as educators and community members.

Members commit to:

- Actively supervise youth gatherings
- Encourage healthy relationships
- Prohibit the possession of alcohol, tobacco or other drugs and misuse of over-the-counter and prescription medication
- Secure, monitor or dispose of prescription medication
- Be open to communication with other members
- · Set age-appropriate family guidelines
- · Secure all weapons in the home
- Encourage responsible driving habits (wear seat belts, never drive impaired and prohibit cell phone use)
- Monitor use of internet, social media, phone and television
