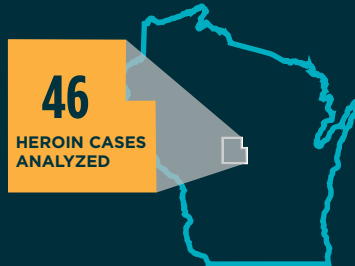


Arrests for possession, delivery or manufacturing of a controlled substance.
