The 2017 Youth Risk Behavior Survey showed that:

IN THE PAST 30 DAYS



13% of Marshfield area HIGH SCHOOL students **USED MARIJUANA** at least once in the past 30 days

Friends think it is wrong or very wrong for them to smoke marijuana	64%	72%
Parents think it is wrong or very wrong for them to smoke marijuana	89%	85%
People have a greater or moderate risk of harming themselves if they smoke marijuana once or twice a week	87%	80%

Used marijuana during their life	27%	23%
Tried marijuana for the first time before age 13 years	5%	4%
